GOLF INFORMATION

BAG DROP

The bag drop station is located to the left of the Clubhouse entrance. Please call the golf shop at 913-432-1224 if no one is available to assist you and a staff member will come get your bag and direct you to the pro shop for check in.

PRO SHOP

Please check in with one of the Golf Professionals in the Pro Shop. The Pro Shop accepts cash, checks and credit cards. Guest fees and cart fees can either be charged to the host member or paid for by the guest. Merchandise is also available in the Pro Shop to purchase.

DRIVING RANGE & PRACTICE AREA

Guests can warm up at our practice facility before their round of golf. We have a driving range, putting clock and short game area. The use of personal practice balls is limited to the chipping green and the putting clock.

PACE OF PLAY

Golfers are expected to maintain Milburn's approved Pace of Play standard of **4:11** and/or keep pace with the group in front of them.

- Always practice ready golf
- Be at your ball prepared to play when it is your turn to play
- Take extra clubs with you from your cart
- Practice continuous putting until your ball is holed, provided you are not interfering with your playing partner's line of play
- Make every effort to keep up with the group in front and not just in front of the group behind
- Keep an eye on the time and try to clear the first 9 holes in 2 hours and 5 minutes

CART RULES

All carts must be operated in a careful, responsible manner. When on the path with electric carts, all four tires of the cart should be on the path at all times. When cart traffic is "off the paths", golf carts are not permitted within 30 yards of any green or bunker and must stay on the cart path near all trees. Please enter at the post marked "On" and exit at the post marked "Off" and remain in the fairway between these two points, we do not ride in the rough.

GOLF INFORMATION CONTINUED

CARE OF THE COURSE

Players must exercise reasonable care to maintain the golf course and practice areas. At all times, players should leave the course in better condition than they found it. As such, players must:

- Repair all divots and ball marks
- Rake all bunkers
- Dispose of all trash, including broken/used tees
- Operate carts in accordance with Club Rules/Policies
- Juniors must have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart

GOLF ATTIRE

Gentlemen's Golf Attire for Golf Course and Practice Areas:

- Slacks, Bermuda or mid-thigh length shorts
- Shirts must have collars, turtlenecks or mock turtleneck collars
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Headwear must always face forward
- Metal spikes are not permitted at MCC
- No denim jeans are permitted
- No athletic pants/sweat pants are permitted

Ladies Golf Attire for Golf Course and Practice Areas:

- Skirts, slacks or mid-thigh length shorts
- Sleeveless shirts must have a collar
- Metal spikes are not permitted at MCC

The following attire is not acceptable on the Golf Course or Practice Areas:

- T-Shirts
- Athletic/ Active wear (warm up suits, yoga pants, etc.)
- Denim Jeans (regardless of color)
- Cargo Shorts and Cargo Pants
- Athletic Shorts
- Swimwear
- Halter Tops
- Tank Tops

CLUBHOUSE INFORMATION

CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE

- Attire should be neat, clean and in good taste. Plus, appropriate for a family country club atmosphere.
- Tennis attire, golf attire and casual attire in general are acceptable in all areas of the clubhouse.
- Attire that is not considered appropriate at any time: fitness attire, swimwear (without cover) and soiled clothing.
- Children under the age of 13 should dress appropriately, but at the discretion of their accompanying adult.
- For men, wearing hats in all dining areas is not allowed.

SMOKING INSIDE THE CLUBHOUSE

In accordance with the City of Overland Park smoking is prohibited in all areas of the clubhouse. Smoking is allowed on the patios.

TENNIS INFORMATION

TENNIS SHOP

Please check in with one of the Tennis Professionals in the Tennis Shop. Merchandise is also available in the Tennis Shop to purchase. The Tennis Shop accepts cash or checks.

TENNIS ATTIRE

Standard tennis attire must be worn on the courts, including shirts and tennis shoes with non marking soles.

PARKING

Guests can park in the main parking lot of the Clubhouse, however we do have two lots closer to the tennis courts off of Santa Fe south of the Clubhouse (highlighted below).
